Effective September 1, 2016, all new studies will be notified of a change in policy. New studies initiated after December 31, 2016, will be charged an annual fee, and continuing studies that go beyond December 31, 2016, will be charged a reduced fee:

New studies administered via Assessment Center	\$5,000/year
Continuing studies administered via Assessment Center	\$2,500/year

a. New Studies using www.AssessmentCenter.net (data collection starting on or after January 1, 2017)

New studies will be charged an annual fee of \$5,000 per study beginning January 1, 2017, to offset the cost of operating the website. Please contact <u>help@assessmentcenter.net</u> for additional information.

b. Continuing (PRE-EXISTING) studies using www.AssessmentCenter.net (launched prior to January 1, 2017)

Continuing studies may use <u>www.AssessmentCenter.net</u> at a pre-paid charge of \$2,500/year. Users will be charged *per study* created in Assessment Center, not per grant. This fee will be waived for studies that complete data collection prior to April 1, 2017 and for students or K-awardees that are scheduled to complete data collection prior to July 1, 2017.
